Code of Conduct

Permission is granted to tenants, employees, and customers to remain on Dimond Center Property during business hours provided they refrain from the following conduct or activities which are prohibited:

1. Engaging in any criminal activities defined by Anchorage Municipal Code or Alaska State Criminal Code.
2. Relocating or misusing Dimond Center furniture; including, but not limited to, placing feet on chairs or benches or leaning back on two legs of a chair.
3. Putting cigarettes on the floor or furniture in any designated smoking area or otherwise littering on Dimond Center property.
4. Gathering in groups that block traffic ways, stairs, escalators, elevators, or storefronts.
5. Entering the service halls and stairwells designated for employees only.
6. Skateboarding, roller skating/blades, or riding bicycles/scooters at Dimond Center
7. Bringing animals into Dimond Center for purposes other than to assist handicapped individuals or for pet care within Dimond Center
8. Horse play - running, jumping, pushing, jostling other mall patrons.
9. Creating loud noise - amplified or yelling.
10. Wearing apparel with spikes, studs, martial arts equipment, gang affiliated clothing, or other paraphernalia which may be dangerous or harmful to persons or property on, or at, the Dimond Center.
11. Spitting or throwing anything while on Dimond Center property.
12. Distributing of handbills or soliciting in unauthorized locations, or panhandling.
13. Using obscene or offensive language or gestures (spoken or displayed).
14. Damaging plants or landscaping.
15. Entering restrooms designated for the opposite sex.
16. Posting handbills, posters, or other literature on Dimond Center property.
17. Failure to be fully clothed (shirt, shoes, etc.).
18. Using sexually explicit language or conduct.
19. Sitting on handrails, stairs, escalators, or trash receptacles, or playing around them.
20. Engaging in any other activity which, in the reasonable exercised judgment of the landlord, and its security officers, is an annoyance or nuisance to other persons entitled to use Dimond Center for its intended purpose.
